



THE PARTY CONTINUES ON: 2C-B by David Holthouse in Rolling Stone

magazine – Dec. 11, 2008 "The self-proclaimed father of more than 200 psychedelics, 83 y/o chemist Alexander 'Sasha' Shulgin is the Thomas Edison of tripping. His favorite creation? 2C-B. "It's visually very pleasant, with a strong element of the erotic." Shulgin says. "It's short-lived, with no hangover.... All in all, one of the most graceful compounds I have ever invented."

What sets 2C-B apart from heavier hallucinogens like LSD is that it responds well to what seasoned psychonauts call "intentionality." To laymen, that means 2C-B is usually mellow enough that users can easily control their experiences. "2C-B responds well to self-direction," says Dr. Neal Goldsmith, New York psychotherapist and psychedelic expert. "It's easily controllable. The experience is determined by your goal."

Usurping LSD as the drug of choice at this year's Burning Man, 2C-B is rapidly proliferating throughout clubs and underground parties, according to reports from DJs and promoters. At \$20 to \$40 a pill, the stuff's not cheap, especially considering that the peak effects of a one-pill "museum dose" lasts about two hours, just enough time to enjoy 2C-B's aphrodisiac qualities. As Goldsmith puts it, "Any physical contact results in volcanic uprising of sexual energy. Users report all the feelings of love associated with MDMA [aka Ecstasy, X, E] – and none of the performance problems."

Higher and higher until the song became one note and broke on the last great


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shout of power like a wave thundering on a beach...

No - I never heard of a dance called "the Stomp." Good try though.



#### Looks like Wall Street has done it again.


Geez don't those financial guys ever learn that just because some scheme can make money for a while it isn't necessarily a sound investment strategy.


But but but good ol' Bernie Madoff said it was a sure thing. And he's a genius - right?

Golly girl - you've got all the compassion and empathy of a Wall Street financial wizard.


No anal sex with you! I hear that the last guy that tried that got electrocuted. Talk about a hot piece of tail – whew!


A combination of vegetable and light machine oils works best for us.

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#### TRUST THE EXPERTS - THEY KNOW BEST?

If we have this right and it has been a little difficult to sort out the facts. Dear Ones I would like to brag here a bit. And, no, "pride goeth before the fall" does not apply to me – infinite beings have nowhere to fall, now do they - ha

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ha ha. So where was I? Getting a little absent-minded in my old age – it all starts getting a little fuzzier after the first 10,000,000,000 years or so. Anyway, please listen to what one of my wiser devotees has been learning:





Oh precious Great Lord Gad I am so blessed by your gifts of wisdom, and honored by your trust in me. A little nervous too – but I suppose it's better than going to be crucified, so here goes:

- 1) Not only do individuals develop spiritually but spirituality, itself evolves (in the realm of form, though not in the formless), and this has been accelerating, so there are states and processes available to spiritual seekers today that weren't in the past, even the recent past. Thus, traditional spiritual teachings and views may benefit from being updated. In particular, I think that the traditional view of something like "only a few in each generation can attain the highest states of liberation" is definitely no longer true, and thank goodness.
- 2) Traditional spiritual teachings have often claimed that various siddhis, and subjective states of bliss, etcetera are inherently part of true spiritual awakening. I find more congruence with teachers like Adyashanti who say things something like 'if you expect enlightenment to improve your life in any way you are in for a rude surprise.'

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- 3) Traditional schools of liberation have tended to teach that either a) you have an ego and that is a problem, but if you do this and this and this then you may overcome your ego and awaken; or b) there is only consciousness so there is no ego, and if you realize this you'll awaken. In neither case do many people ever awaken. Right? There is another path that teaches that while it is true that in one way you can say that only consciousness exists, it is also true that the ego exists and is real, but that having an ego doesn't stop one from awakening. That is, one can awaken with their ego intact and then live in a paradox of being aware of simultaneously existing as both an infinite and free spirit, and yet also as a very finite and limited person. Saniel Bonder's Healing the Spirit–Matter Split is a nice simple exposition of this.
- 4) Realizers of liberation will fall somewhere on a yin-yang continuum and there is often much misunderstanding between individuals and schools at the poles. Yin realizers tend to identify solely with consciousness, so much so that any impulse in another person other than the simple abiding in consciousness, is seen as evidence that the other is not truly awakened. In contrast, more yang realizers tend to have a fundamental impulse to interact with the world of form, and tend to see the yin types as somewhat disassociated.
- 5) All individuals including the most spiritually realized have 'lines of development.' Being spiritually awakened does not mean that the individual is especially developed physically, mentally, or even psychologically. The lack of this insight created a lot of grief in the boomers' early exposure to eastern teachers. Understanding this allows the creation of much healthier relationships between students and teachers. This is especially true given that virtually all traditional schools of spirituality arose in societies and epochs with feudal worldviews which have rigid hierarchical authority structures.
