
Round Eight


anhedonia - the lack of pleasure and the ability to experience it.

DIFFERENT WAYS OF THINKING: From Newsweek's 04/14/08 "On Science" by Sharon Begley – a discussion of <u>The Geography of Thought: How Asians and</u> <u>Westerners Think Differently ... and Why</u> Richard Nisbett (2003)

"Westerners typically see classifications where Asians see relationships." Examples: Shown pictures of a monkey, a panda, and a banana and asked which two are related most Japanese said the monkey and the banana while the Westerners usually picked the monkey and the panda, i.e functional relationship vs. categories. Also after looking at an aquarium holding a large fish, a bunch of the small fry and the usual aquarium plants and rocks, the Japanese later said they'd seen lots of background elements; the Americans saw the big fish. In viewing culturally nonspecific cartoons East Asians tend to first take the background context into account whole Westerners initially concentrate on objects in the foreground."

"The West epitomizes individualistic, do-your-own-thing cultures, ones where the rights of the individual equal and often trump those of the group and where differences are valued. East Asian societies exalt the larger society: behavior is constrained by social rules, conformity is prized, outsiders shunned. "The individualistic-collectivist split is one of the most powerful differences among cultures."

As to why cultures fall where they do there is finally a theory: "You Can Blame the Bugs." It turns out that the more pathogens in the environment (climate and topography - closer to the equator and lower altitude) the more adaptive the collectivist behavior and vice versa. And when people move to a different kind of culture they tend to adopt their prevalent worldview, so it isn't in the genes. Question: Whose culture is kicking whose economic ass these days?

SPEAKING OF BUGS AND HEALTH – A positive correlation has been found between women who are ill during their pregnancies and an elevated risk to their children of mental illness later in life. 



That was the last time we'll answer an ad to participate in ground-breaking genetics research!


- I said to her "great tits," and she smiled. Then I said "nice pussy" and she ran for the door like she was in fear for her life. I was confused for a moment, but then I got it.




Look at this way – maybe you'll get to reincarnate as a cat.
